- All Saints' College made history as it became the first Arts and Science College to collaborate with IEEE-HAC (Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers(IEEE) - Humanitarian Activities Cell) to launch the Community of Practice Initiative. Community of Practice Initiative aims to reach out to the

- Our college is the recipient of a prestigious International grant of US \$4,959.00 sanctioned by the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers(IEEE) Humanitarian Activities Cell (HAC)/SIGHT (Special Interest Group on Humanitarian Technology) to help the geriatric community who are at risk following the pandemic. The project is titled "Telemedicine ready Pulse Oxygen Saturation Temperature Monitoring Appliance (POSTMA)". The project aims to extend support to the health workers who will be able to efficiently monitor the COVID patients under reverse quarantine. The project will lead by Dr. Anjana P.S from the Department of Physics and she will be assisted by Dr. Veena Suresh Babu, Dr. Vidya Nair, Dr. Vijayakumari K., Dr. Ayona Jayadev and Dr. Kavita.
- ➤ All Saints' College has been founded on the principles of compassion and charity. Our beloved Manager, Rev. Mother Mary Frances became a paragon of these ideals when she reached out to the larger community at Poonthura by providing them with timely assistance. The Management of All Saints' College sponsored a Research Project on Mangrove Afforestation at the Poonthura Coast so as to create a protective biowall around the area that had been devastated by the Ockhi cyclone.
