poster designing competition based on the theme of AIDS to spread awareness. Best two entries were awarded with certificates of appreciation.












## 4. CLUB ACTIVITIES






The AICUF student were given orientation and were welcomed by conducting freshersday. Rev FR Prince delivered a session on Social commitment.
