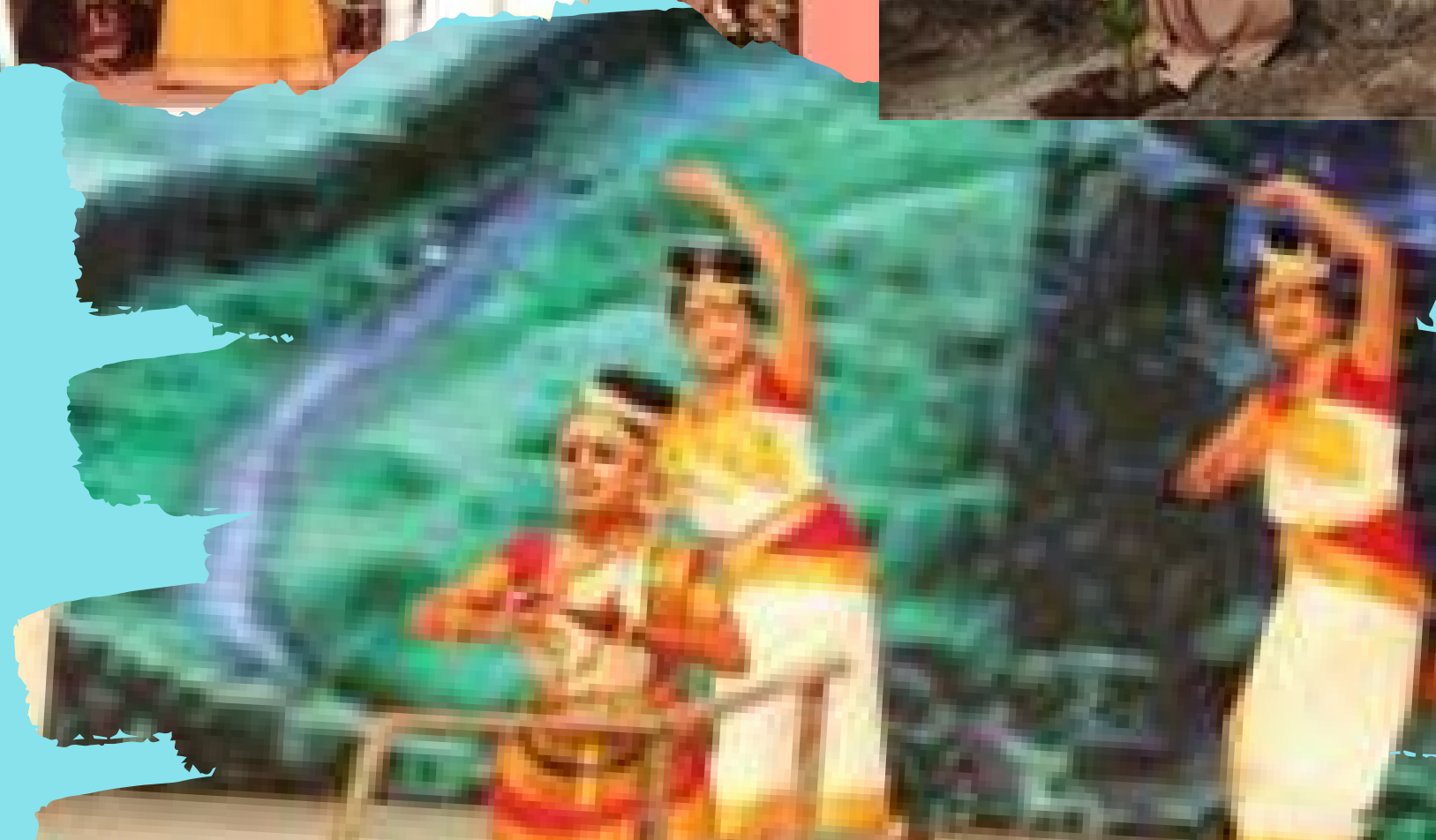

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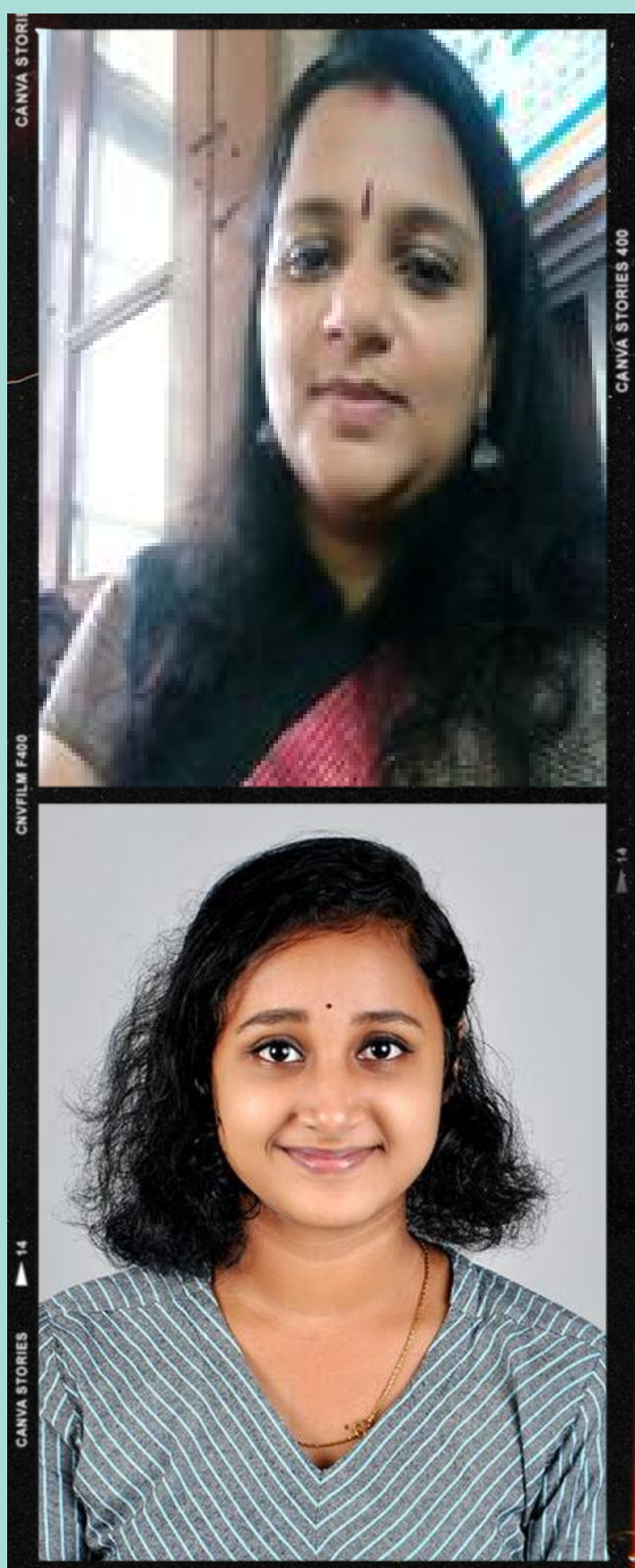
FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

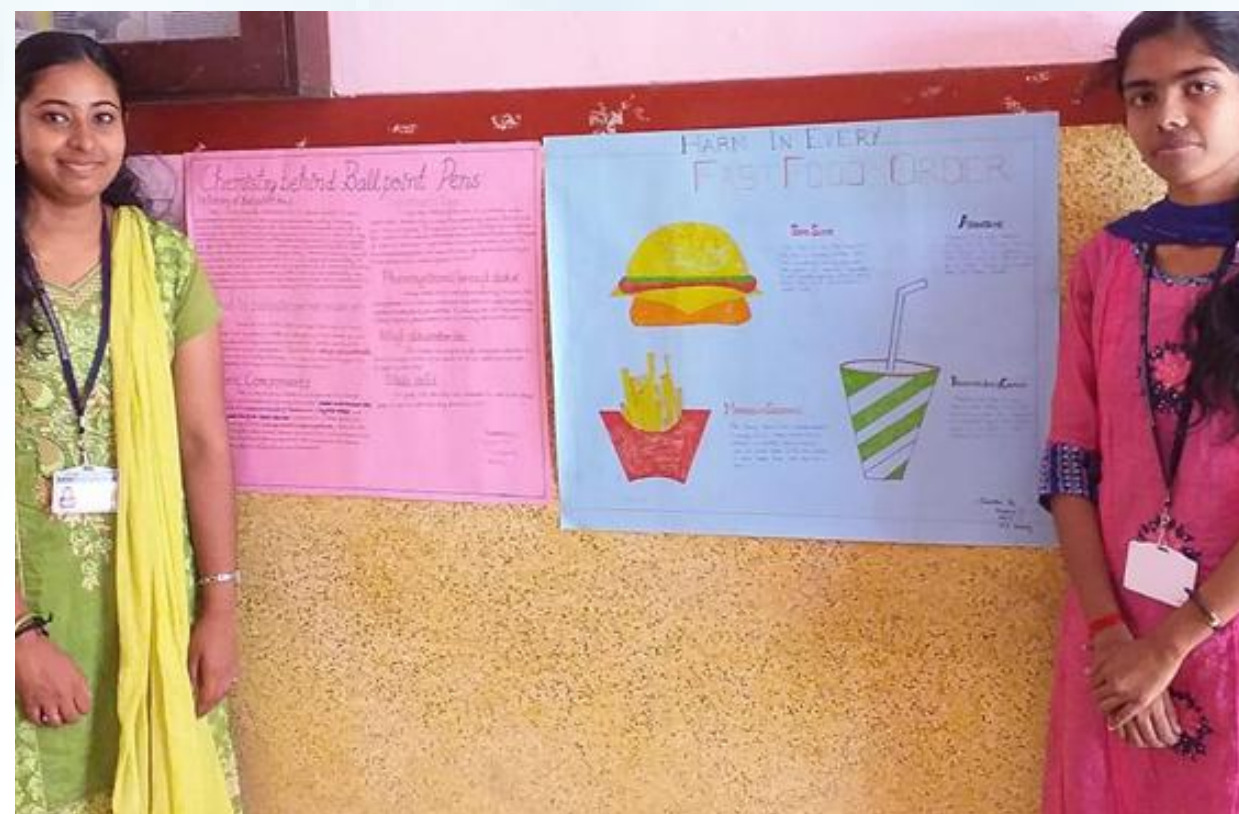

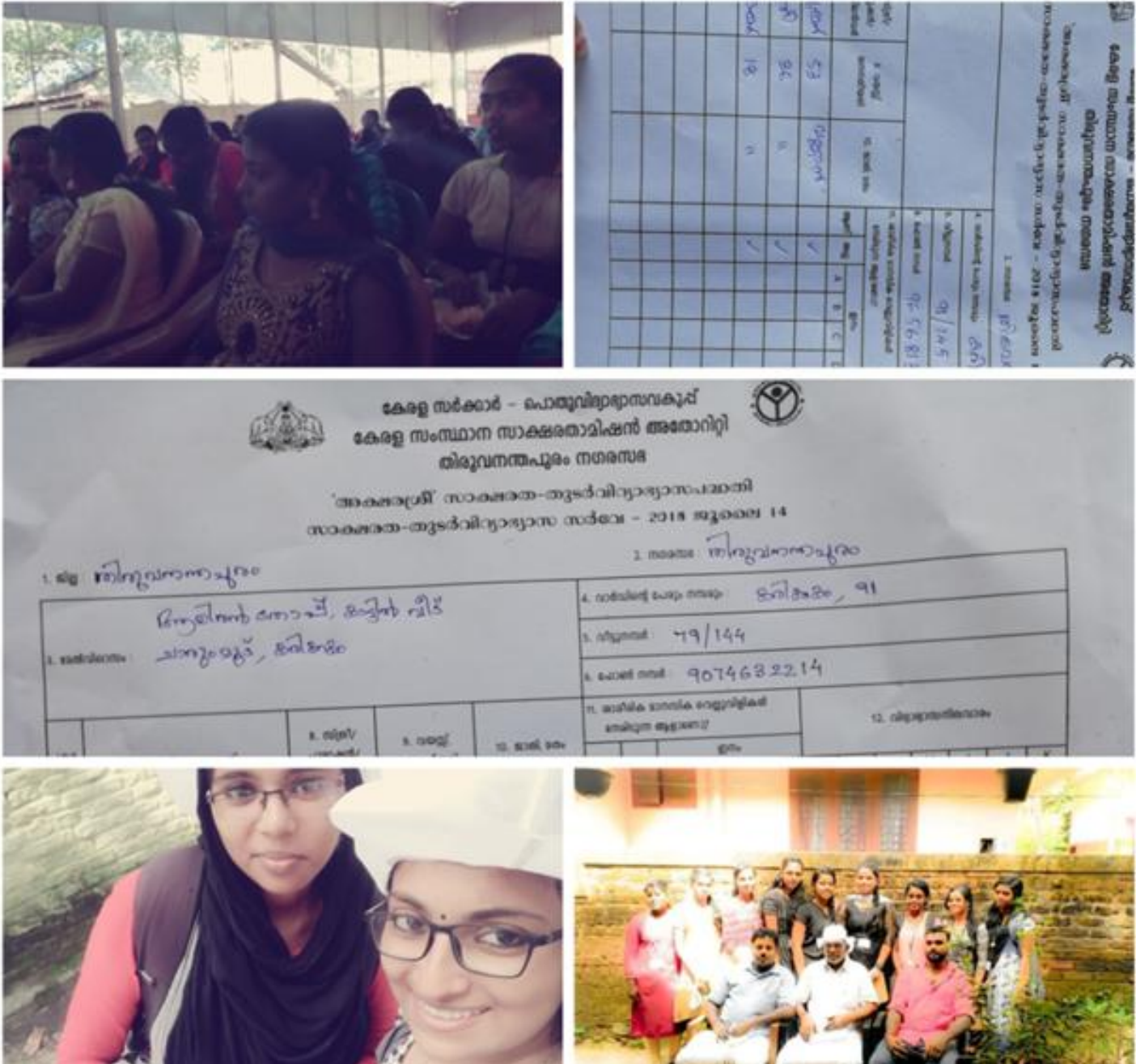


• 13/07/2018: ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEETING
