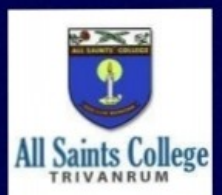

Guidelines



Poem writing

- It's a half an hour live competition conducted via google meet.
- The poem can be in Malayalam / English / Hindi.
- Poem should not be more than 4 stanza.
- The poem should be original any plagiarized work will be disqualified.
- The poem will be judged based on the content.

Recitation

- The poem you chose to recite must be in Malayalam/ English/Hindi.
- The time limit is 5 minutes. Any entry that exceeds the time limit will be disqualified.
- Send your entries in mp3 format.
- Editing the audio or usage of any kinds of voice filters changers is not allowed.
- Mention the name of the poem and the poet while sending your entries.
- Send you full name, department and year of study along with the entry.

Calligraphy

- The size of the sheet/paper should be A4.
- Participants can use brush, pen, pencils, crayons, watercolours etc.
- A single participant should be involved in the competition.
- Submit a clear picture of your work taken with mobile phone /camera.
- Work should be your own copying from any other sources should be disqualified.
- The crieteria of judgement will be based on clarity neatness and creativity.
- You must write your name with signature and date at the end of the sheet.

Story telling

- You can record your videos either in portrait or landscape mode.
- The time limit is 6 minutes and any entry which exceeds the time limit would be disqualified.
- You should not mention your department in your video.
- Your story should be your own creation and any plagiarized work would be disqualified.
- You may not wear any special costumes and usage of props is not allowed.
- You can edit and make your videos creative on your own way but usage of voice filters is not allowed.
- You will be judged according to your story pronunciation fluency presentation and creativity.

Bookmark making

- Artwork must be original.
- Only 1 entry per person.
- No computer generated art.
- Bookmark measure should be 2" * 5"
