


Poster-Making Competition

Orientation Programme

An Orientation on Anti-Ragging on 16-08-2023 at the Recreation Hall from 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm. The objective was to enlighten the first-year students of the college about ragging and its ill effects. The programme commenced with a talk by the Vice Principal, Dr. D'Souza Pascoela Adelrich. Following this, the Principal, Prof. (Dr.) Reshmi R. Prasad, addressed the students. In the next phase of the programme, faculty members spoke about the menace of ragging.

Dr. Vijayakumari K, Assistant Professor, Department of History, emphasised the need of personality development to curb the tendency of ragging. Dr. Carvalho Faustina Cicila, Head, Department of Commerce related the negative effects of ragging in an informative and entertaining manner. A short film on anti-ragging was also shown. After this, a role-play debate, with members from the audience, was held. The orientation ended with an opinion session, which had positive and enthusiastic responses from the audience.
