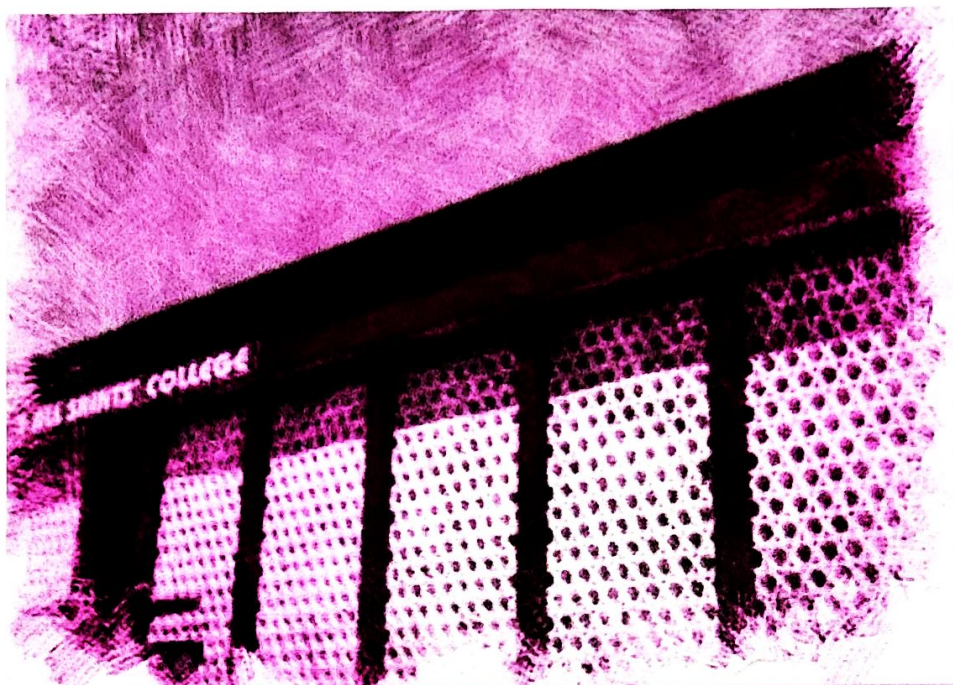

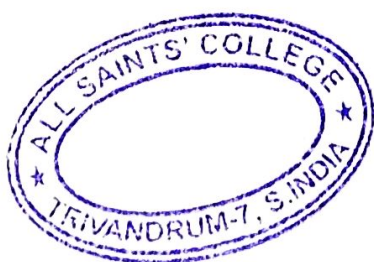

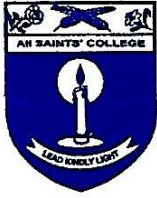

Talks and Workshops

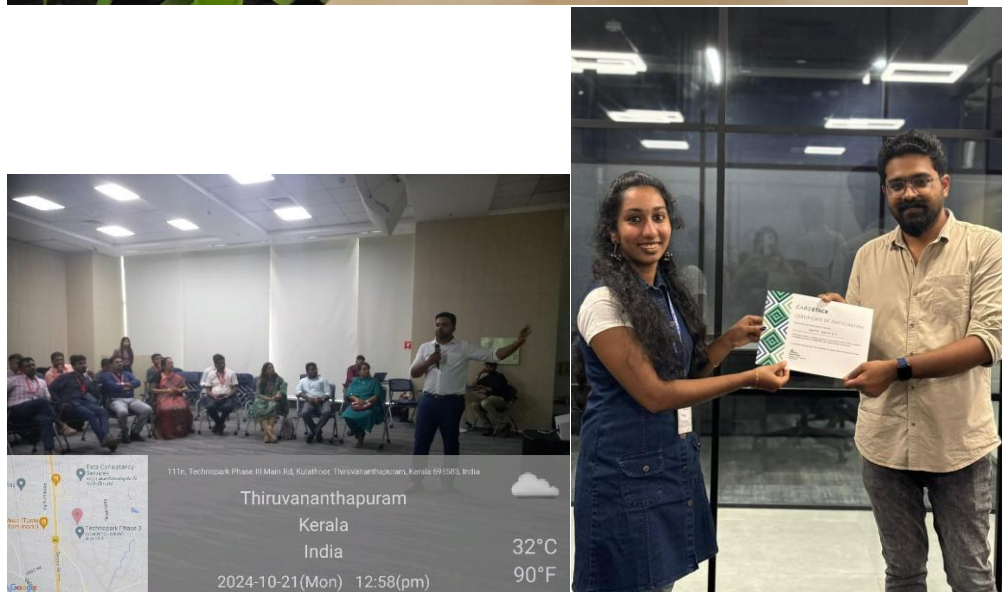

4. The placement officers had a Campus to Corporate Meet @ Allianz, Technopark 21/10/2024.

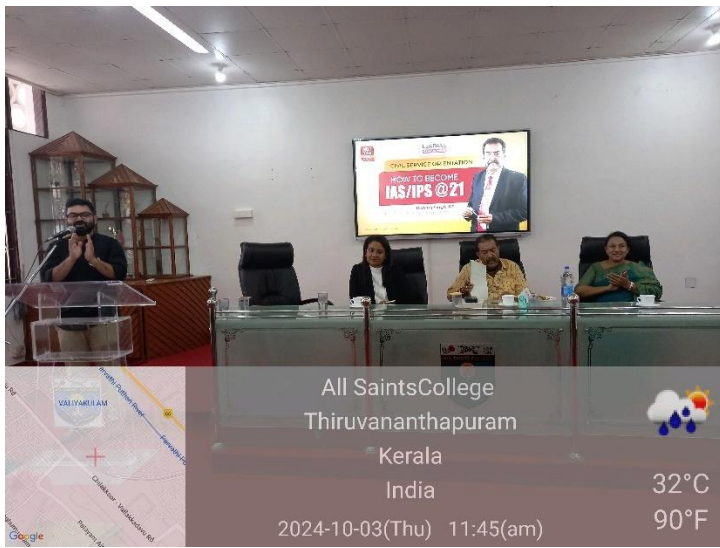




Be Ambitious
