The activities of the Club are designed to ensure mental wellness, social awareness, resistance to domestic abuse and to express creativity.

On 9 March, 2022, **Dr. Thaji T G**, Assistant Professor, Government Law College, Thiruvananthapuram conducted a class on Legal Awareness for the students.

A Scrap to Art hands on training workshop was organised by the Department of Environmental Sciences of All Saints' College from 24-6-2022 to 30-6-2022. The program was organised in collaboration with Sustera Foundation, a registered NGO which mainly focuses on Climate Action Programs and Environmental Sustainability initiatives. Participative Action and Legaaming was the main highlight of the programme. Total of 40 participants look part in the program. Wall art installations which also act as photo points for students were installed in different areas alloted in the college campus. Used bottle caps and used plastic pers were mainly used for creating the Wall Art Installations. The main idea behind creating these installations was to focus on circular economy there by promoting reduction of waste in the source itself. A collection drive was initiated in the campus for collection of used bottle caps and used pens. For this purpose, cardboard boxes were placed in different points in the campus and announcements were made to bring the same and deposit in the collection points. In addition to this, the students of the Department of Environmental Sciences went to the Plastic Shredding Unit at Cheriathura under Thiruvananthapuram Corporation and collected used bottle caps from the unit. Through this Participative Learning Approach, the students were thus given awareness to minimise usage of plastics inside and outside the campus so that most of the a plastic waste which is generated in the campus and their households can be a wisely utilised by way of creating art installation like this. Another Wall Art installation using electronic waste was also installed in the campus using the unwanted electronic parts which were discarded from the college office. Artifacts and pen holders were als made during the workshop using electronic waste.
