### 2.1.2 ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All Saints' College, Thiruvananthapuram is an aided affiliated college under the University of Kerala. Our college is an aided backward college with minority status (Latin Catholic).

With regard to the admission procedures, the College strictly abides by the rules prescribed by the Government of India, the State Government and the University of Kerala. College is permitted to admit students only under Community and Management Quota as per the University rules. The distribution of seats among various categories for UG and PG programmes as prescribed by the University is shown in the table given below (Refer Kerala University UG Prospectus P.No.11):

Sl. No.	Seat Reservation	As percentage of total seats
I	General Merit Quota	40 %
II	Scheduled Caste	15 %
III	Scheduled Tribe	05 %
IV	Community Quota	20 %
V	Management Quota	20 %

For admission to seats under general merit quota and SC/ ST quota, students can apply only through the Centralized Allotment Process of the University of Kerala. As per the University rules, the seats unavailed by the SC candidates will go to ST candidates and vice versa. Other Eligible Community (OEC) candidates are eligible for the un-availed seats, if any, under SC/ST quota. The vacant SC/ST seats if any, in Backward Aided colleges with Minority Status will be filled by admitting candidates from the Community Quota Rank list of the colleges, strictly in accordance with the rules and guidelines for admission (Refer Kerala University UG Prospectus P.No.13).
