#### CYBER SECURITY FUNDAMENTALS

The Department of History and Political Science of All Saints' College conducted a Certificate Course on Cyber Security Fundamentals. The course was conducted in association with Strava Technologies Pvt. Ltd. and Manoj and Chitra International Legal Service Providers. The 30-hour certificate course was conducted from 3rd July 2021 to 1st October 2021. The course co-ordinator was Dr. Parvathy Menon. There were 150 students from various departments of the college participated in this course. They were grouped into three batches. The course was organised mainly to provide an awareness for the students about cyber crimes, cyber laws and the precautions and solutions while dealing with a cyber crime. Group discussions and debates were conducted on the prevailing cyber issues. Students received a wide knowledge on Cyber security.

There were sessions on Introduction to Cyber Security, Practical solutions for Cyber Attacks, Cyber Hacking, Cyber Bullying, how to secure data and information online, Detailed explanation about cyber-attacks like ransomware, Phishing, Surfing on Cyber space safety and Threads and precautions to be followed during surfing, Cyber security policy to be adopted by employers, how to use social media, how to understand cookies and post matters without compromising privacy. Case study on various policies in various company and privacy policy on social media, Discussion forum on ransomware and how to tackle with the help of cyber police force, Cyber forensic and protection of rights and duties of internet users were discussed. Regular Court Procedures and online procedures to be followed when cybercrimes are committed, Sexual offences against women using internet, Crypto currencies and related legal issues in India Information Technology Act and its relevance to cyber crimes, Jurisdiction of cyber-crimes and pronounced case laws discussion on cybercrimes by Supreme Court of India and All High Courts in India, Comparative study on cyber-crime prevention methodology with other countries were also dealt with. Certificates were provided to the students after the successful completion of the course.
