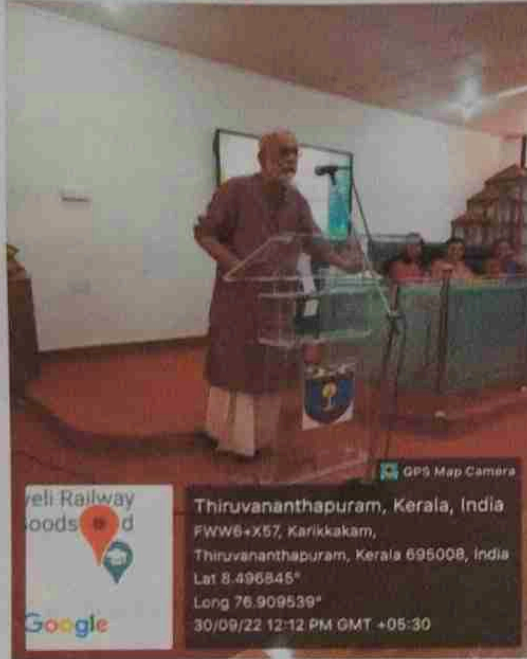

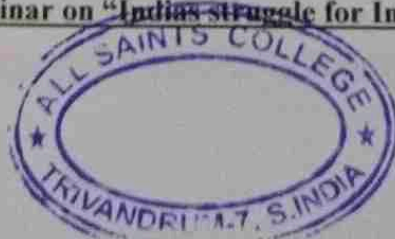

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❖ National webinar on “~~India's struggle~~ for Independence: A Global Perspective”

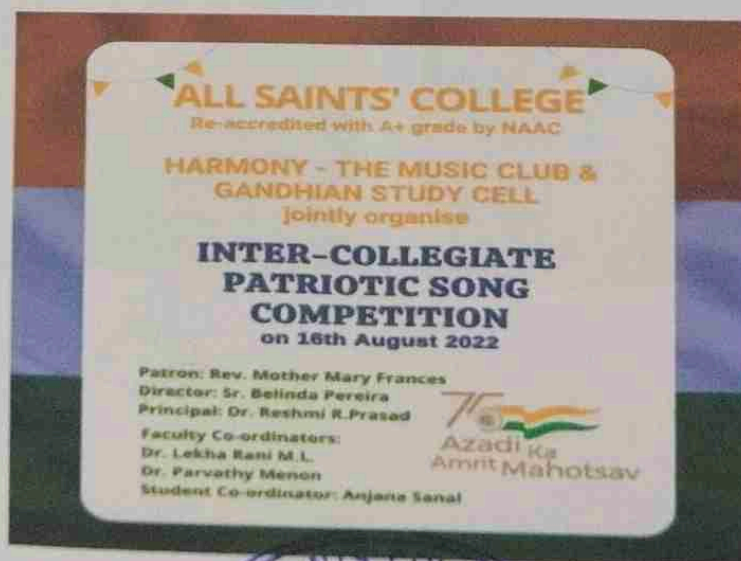

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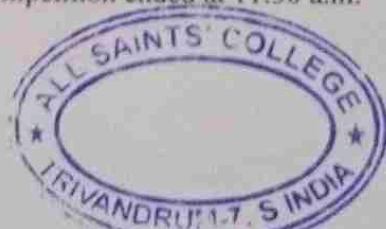




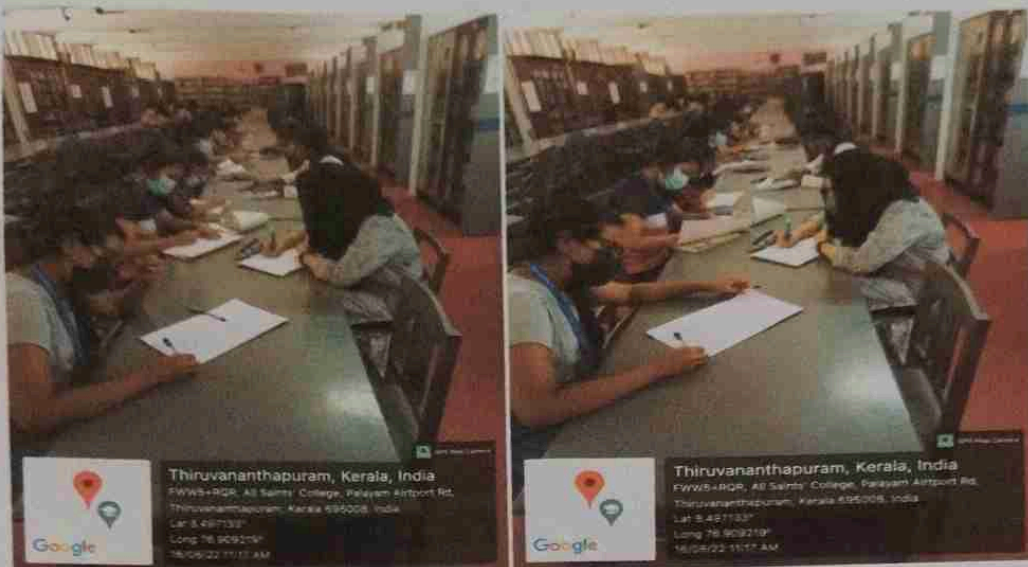
As a part of AZAADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV, Gandhian Study Cell of the Dept of History and Library club jointly conducted the following competitions.

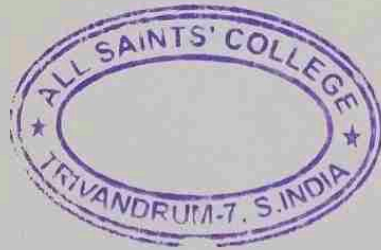


Poster making competition on 17th August 2022

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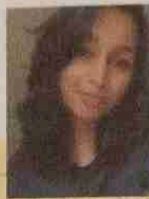

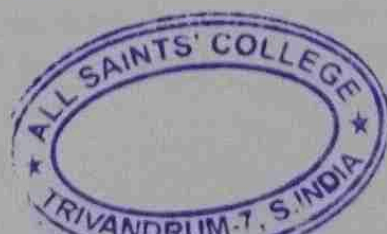

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The Freedom Wall was inaugurated by Principal, Prof. Reshmi RPrasad on August 15, 2022.

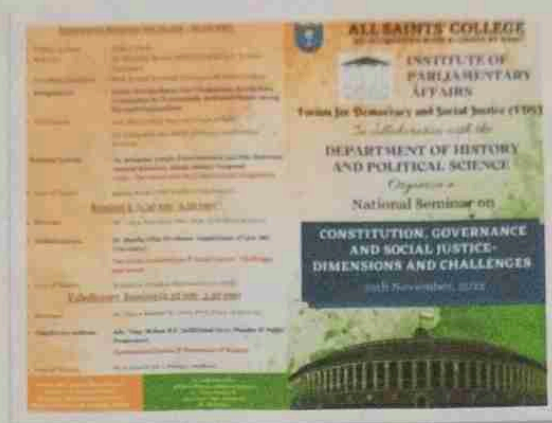

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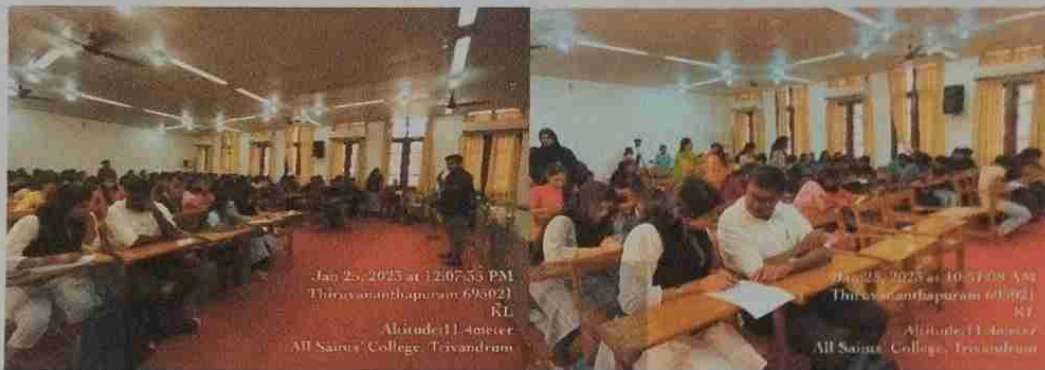
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REPORT ON INTER-COLLEGIATE QUIZ COMPETITION

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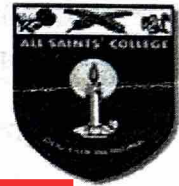

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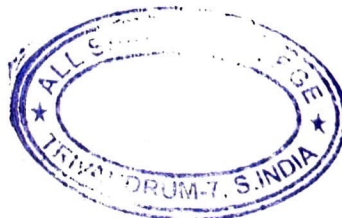
