A Review of the NAAC accreditation was presented by the IQAC Coordinator. She presented each criterion separately.

Institutional CGPA = 3281/970 = 3.8 GRADE : A+

The college should use advanced methods like psychological tests for finding out slow learners and advanced learners and organize special programmes for them. Moreover, teachers should adopt student centric methods and use ICT enabled tools for efficient teaching learning process. Mechanism of grievance redressal system should be made more efficient.

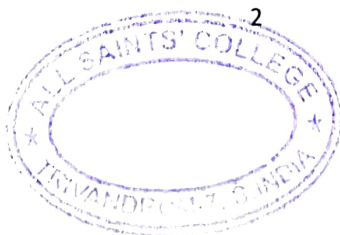
