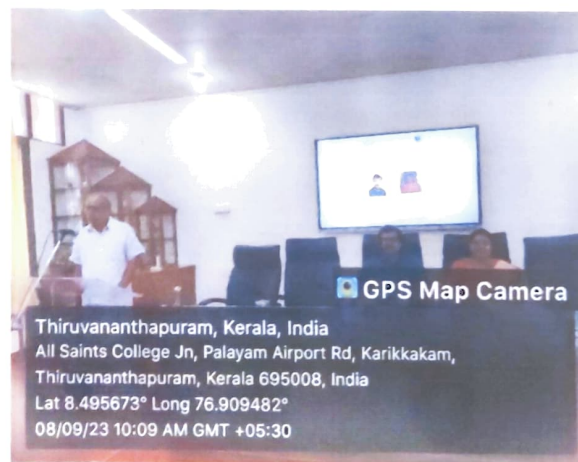



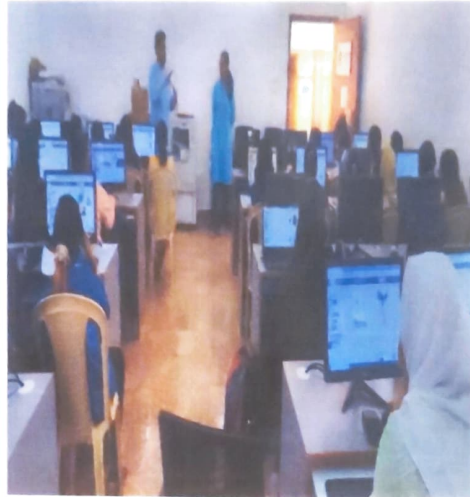

The cell organised a basic preparation for self-defence by trained professionals on 13 March 2024. All the first-year students of the college attended the same.

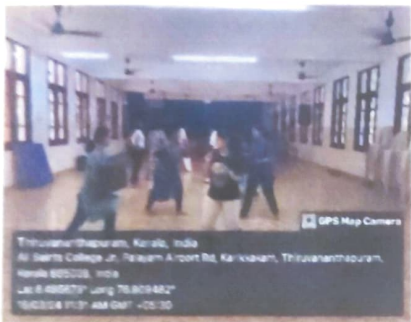
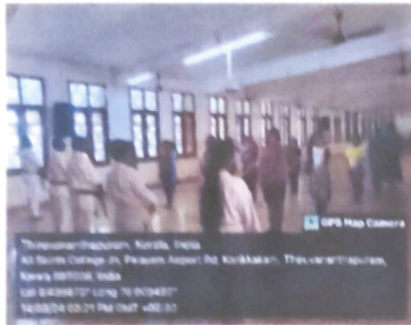
