Library

- The college has a Digital Library (https://allsaintsdigital.libsoft.org/) and a strong system of digital repositories of study resources.
- The Integrated Library Management System (ILMS)-LIBSOFT Version 5.1 is used to fully automate the Wi-Fi enabled library. LIBSOFT GATE REGISTER uses a barcoded ID card to record member entry and exit along with date and time.

Networks and Digital Databases

- The Library Catalogue (OPAC) can be accessed over the Internet. Web OPAC software with Web Space and Web Database Space are included in this.
