The supervising teacher shall collect and keep the transfer certificate of the candidate so as to ensure that she/he does not undergo any other course either Full-Time or Part-Time before the submission of thesis.

Ph.D Programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years for both Full-Time and Part-Time after which the registration shall automatically lapse. A maximum of an additional two (2) years shall be given as an extension subject to the approval of the Syndicate; provided, however, that the total period for completion of a Ph.D. programme shall not exceed eight (8) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D. programme. Female Ph.D scholars and persons with Disabilities (having more than 40% disability) shall be allowed an additional relaxation of two (2) years; however, the total period for completion of a Ph.D. programme in such cases shall not exceed ten (10) years from the date of admission in the Ph.D programme.

Part-Time research scholars shall spend a period of at least 180 days at a stretch or in not more than three spells as full-time research scholars at the centre of research before they are allowed to submit the thesis.

The course work for Ph.D. shall be of a minimum of 14 credits.

All courses prescribed for Ph.D course work shall be in conformity with the credit hour instructional requirements and shall specify content, instructional and assessment methods duly approved by Academic Committee of CSS in the University.

The Department where the scholar pursues research shall prescribe the course (s) based on the recommendations of the Department Doctoral Committee.

Scholars admitted to the Ph.D programmes shall be required to complete the course work prescribed by the Department during the initial one year from the date of registration for research, failing which the registration for
