**Annual Gender Sensitisation Action Plan – 2023 -2024**

Taking into consideration, the rising threat to privacy and the problems faced by many women, members of the Women's Cell of the College attended a seminar on "Right to Privacy-Problems in the Cyber World organized by the Kerala Women's Commission in association with National Commission for Women on 31 July 2023. The Women's Cell also organized a seminar on 'Need for Changes in Labour Law' focussing on Women's labour in India in association with the Indian Institute of Public Administration on 08 September 2023. The institution also ensured mental health and wellness programs were available to the students through interactive sessions and empowerment initiatives with a course on "Empowering Women, Transforming Lives" on 21 March, 2024.

To ensure that students are safe and secure within the campus, CCTV cameras are placed at various strategic locations and the entry/exit records of all visitors, are maintained scrupulously. The college also organised a Gender Sensitisation talk to encourage inclusivity and awareness of diversity among students with the Rainbow Transgender Awareness Programme organised by the Department of History and Political Science in association with the Social Justice Office, Thiruvananthapuram, Govt. of Kerala with Shakiya S Priyamvada, Consultant and Counsellor for the Mariwala Health Foundation, Mumbai, as the Chief Guest on 7 March, 2024. The College also organised anti-ragging initiatives for the students by observing the Anti-Ragging Week from 12 August 2023 to 18 August 2023 with a series of competitions for the students.
