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### INSPIRE TO ASPIRE

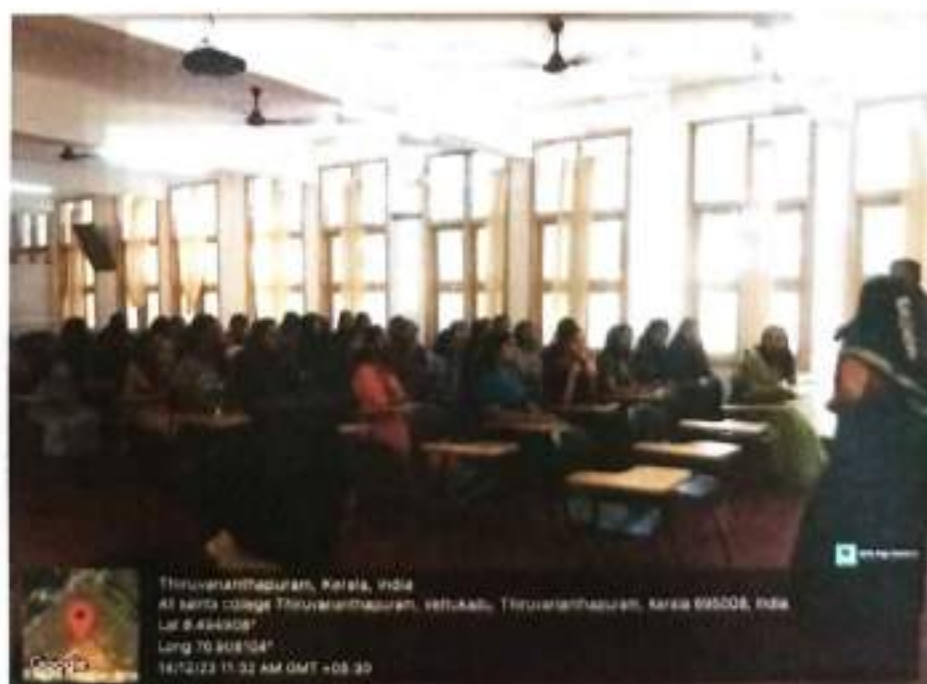

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## 1. **Orientation class on Bird watching**

So far, over 5 lakh youth across India have been engaged in this initiative.

The campaign comprises three phases.

**First- Educate:** in which pupil will learn through quizzes and discussions about the facts related to the topic. The quizzes shall be online and pupil can attend the quiz via the link provided for them.

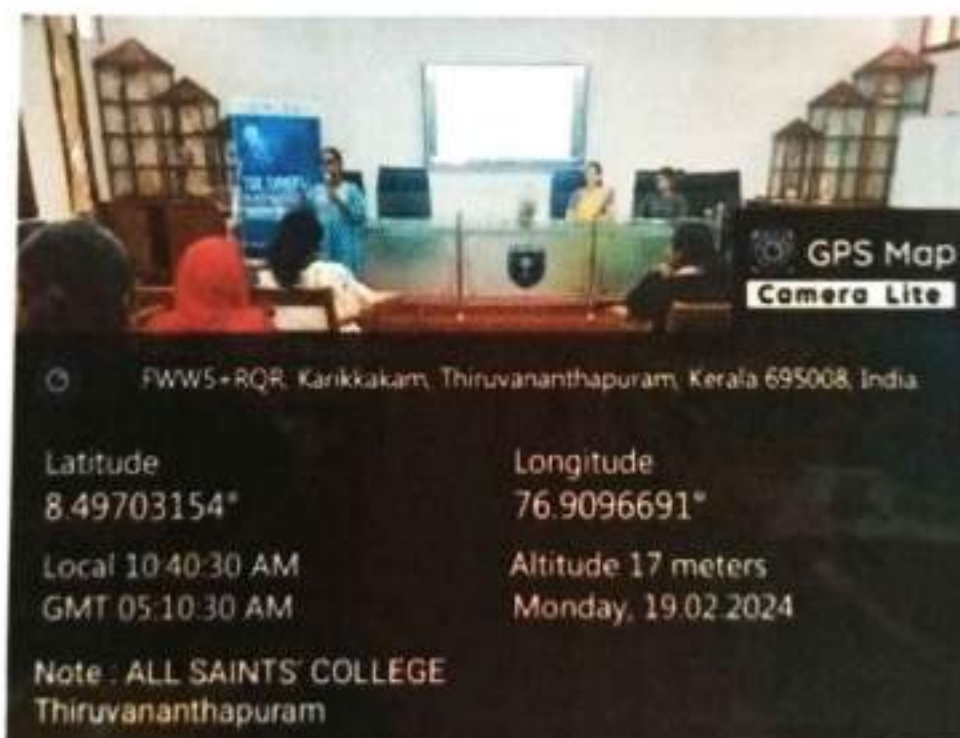

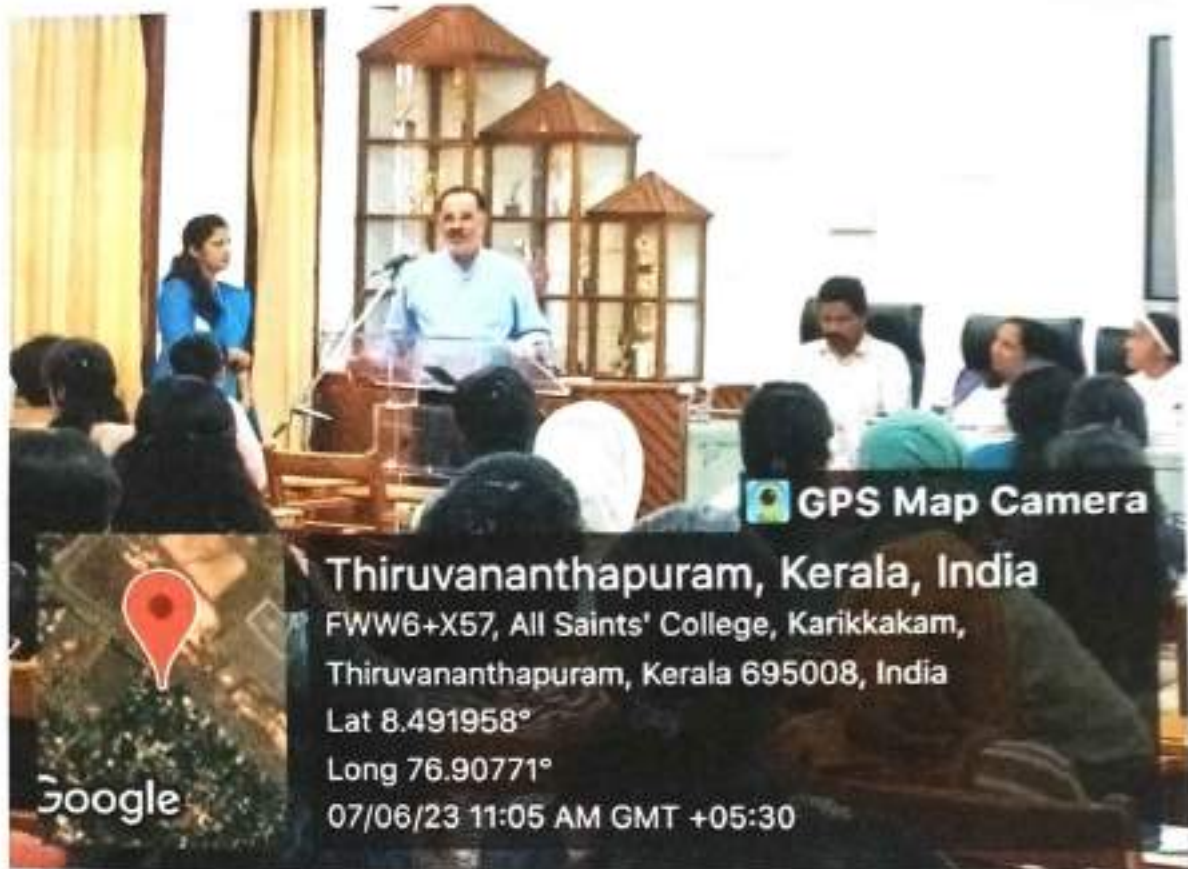

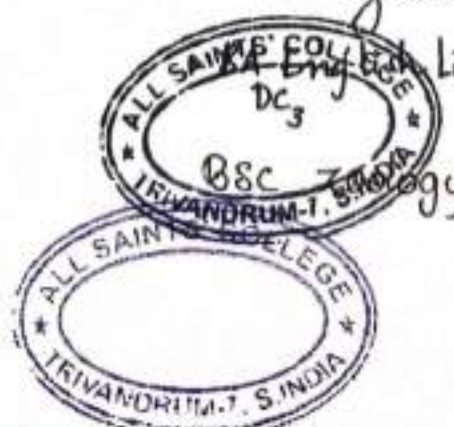
