Sub-committees:

The data obtained from the measurements and impact of the activities and programmes is collected and recorded. In order to ensure clarity and set definitive paradigms for the ways in which the activities of the college translate into meaningful academic and socially effective endeavours, the institution has established the "Saints' Centre for Outreach, Research and Extension (SCORE)".

SCORE is headed by the Principal and is under the direct purview of the IQAC and further delegated to the

- Research Committee by Dr. P.S Anjana (Assistant Professor, Department of Physics)
- Extension Committee by Ms. Vijayakumari (Assistant Professor, Department of History).

The Departments and agencies like SCORE prepare an action plan for the year and the same is forwarded to the Central Planning Committee that makes its recommendations to the Core Committee. Thus, the IQAC sets its agenda and begins procedural activities at the beginning of the year. The agenda and the directives of the IQAC are forwarded to the Central Planning Committee that in turn mobilises the sub committees and realises the goals of the IQAC. The IQAC convenes meetings to gain the updates on the work done by the various sub committees. Thus the various arms of the IQAC work in tandem to ensure academic and holistic growth.
